



Risk Management Plan Check List

In assessing your Risk Management Plan (RMP) and ensuring it is both relevant and appropriate to the activities of your organisation, the following critical points form the basis for assessment:

- Evidence that a Risk Management Plan is in place and implemented across the organisation.
- Maintain training of all staff involved in the handling of extinguishing agents to the standard required to hold a licence in accordance with the requirements of the Board.
- Operational practices are documented for storing, recycling, decanting and/or disposing of extinguishing agents.
- Accurate records are maintained in accordance with the provisions of the regulations.
- Regular monitoring of leakage of extinguishing agent stocks stored in bulk containers.
- Potential emission risks relative to each handling activity are identified and rated.
- Responsible persons are identified for actioning of control measures.
- The RMP is current and has a review date.
- Technicians have appropriate licences (company to supply list of licence holders).
- A copy of the Regulations, Code of Practice & Building Owners Brochure label and factsheets are provided.
